













Info 1 - August 24th, 2018

More than 2 months before the biggest motorsport event held in Portugal and, most probably in the world, summed last year 450 competitors (about 650 drivers/riders and co-drivers), Automóvel Club de Portugal is finishing the preparations for the 32nd edition of this mythical competition.

The 32nd Baja Portalegre 500 will take place from the 25th to the 27th of October.

Entries are available from August 27 to October 12; prices suffer an increase from October 1 on. Registrations are to be done here: http://provasdesportivas.acp.pt

Schedule:

25th October

Administrative checks and Technical scrutineering Reconnaissance of SS1 (prologue), for all competitors, Cars and Bikes. Starting ceremony at Jardim do Tarro (city garden), in the city centre of Portalegre.

26th October

Realization of 2 selective sectors, SS1 (prologue) and SS2 with about 90 km, with a regrouping between both, in the city of Ponte de Sor. SS2 starts at Avis and ends as usual at the prologue. Due to logistical reasons the Hobby and Promotion class bikes won't perform SS2.

27th October

The usual 2 selective sectors for Cars, with about 180 km each and 1 selective sector for Bikes, Quads and SSV with about 330 km.

The Promotion classes, Car and Bike, will only perform a selective sector of about 200 km.

At the end of the day the Podium Ceremony (Parc Fermé) will be held and later the usual Prize Giving Ceremony at Nerpor.

This year we will introduce some new features along the itinerary. We will use tracks that we have not travelled for a long time and other that are completely new.
